Connie Leverage moved that we take part in the celebration in any way we can which will be determined after the May 28th meeting. Motion seconded and approved.

Mike reported that the City of LaVista requested Papillion Garden Club participation at a May 16<sup>th</sup> informational meeting to discuss formation of a LaVista Garden Club. Joyce Stranglen volunteered to attend on behalf of the Papillion Garden Club.

A motion was made, seconded and approved to have a growing contest of butterfly weed. The club will buy 50 - 60 plants and distribute to all members. The members must plant, care for, and take pictures of their butterfly weed.

Jo Ann Prettyman won the raffle prize of a succulent.
